Thursday, October 30 CITY TOUR

Known as Emerald City, Seattle's fascinating landscape and diverse culture will have you constantly exploring. Board your bus and head downtown where you will get an up-close look at some of the city's most vibrant neighborhoods. See the Chinatown-International District filled with diverse and unique shops, restaurants, bars, and history. Continue past Lumen Field and to Pioneer Square where you will see the late 1800s Romanesque Revival buildings surrounded by some of the city's trendiest shops and bars. Finally, arrive at your main destination, the famous Pike Place Market, known for their fish-throwing seafood vendors. There are hundreds of other small businesses, craftspeople, and farmers that make Pike Place Market so wonderful. Enjoy free time to explore on your own and have lunch at one of the many unique options.

Friday, October 31: MUSEUM OF FLIGHT

Head to The Museum of Flight for an aviation filled afternoon. The Museum boasts over 175 air and spacecraft, tens of thousands of artifacts, millions of rare photographs, dozens of exhibits, and a world-class library. Enjoy a one-hour docent guided tour that takes you on a journey through the evolution of flight. Then take some time on your own to explore the six-story steel and glass Great Gallery where over twenty full-size airplanes are suspended in the air, and fifteen are grounded for your close inspection. In the adjacent Red Barn, stroll through exhibits dating from the dawn of aviation. Also on display is the first Air Force One Presidential plane and a Concorde.

Saturday, November 1 CHIHULY GARDEN & GLASS

Dale Chihuly, a Tacoma local, is one of the most prominent glass artists in the world. His work is included in more than 200 museum collections worldwide. Discover the iconic work of Chihuly at the one-of-kind outdoor urban garden where his glasswork is blended with colorful trees, plants, and flowers designed to complement each other. Walk through the Glasshouse where a 100-foot-long sculpture dominates the space and is one of Chihuly's largest suspended sculptures. There are also galleries to showcase his work over 40 years representing experimentation with color, form, and light. If you feel like a small bite to eat or a quick drink head to The Bar where over 25 of Chihuly's personal collections are on display.

There is a limit of one hydraulically lifted scooter or wheelchair per handicap accessible bus. Please note the combined weight of the passenger and motorized wheelchair or scooter may not exceed 500lb due to lift limitations.

If you use a scooter or motorized wheelchair but can climb the steps to board the bus, either you and/or a person travelling with you must be able to put the scooter or wheelchair in the bus's luggage compartment. Due to liability issues, drivers, and tour guides cannot assist with scooters or motorized wheelchairs.
